I. **Purpose:** To parallel area colleges in implementing a grade requirement for readmission students. This requirement is for the purpose of ensuring that the quality of care provided by students is at a minimal level and increasing the statistical pass rates for program graduates.

II. **Application:** This policy will become effective immediately for new and current students (beginning Fall 2011). All nursing students will be given the policy information in their nursing student handbook. The policy will be posted on the nursing website, nursing portal, and noted on the application informational documents. (This change in policy will still allow for a petition process in which students can petition for another repeat if special circumstances exist.)

III. **Policy:** The Full Faculty committee approved to require nursing students who apply for readmission/Re-entry to have a minimum of a "C" level (2.0 in nursing core courses completed at the time of departure) to qualify for re-entry. This policy is effective immediately (5/31/11). Students who request to depart, or withdraw from the program will meet with the Director of Nursing (within 10 business days). At that time, the student will be given their GPA and a ranking status. Any student whom does not meet the minimum 2.0 GPA will be informed of their GPA via form 0.20 at the time of departure.
