I. Purpose: Curriculum changes are underway, and due to begin Fall 2011. A student who fails an individual nursing course, or leaves the program, may re-enter Yuba College's Nursing Program only once. Re-entry is not guaranteed, and is dependent on space availability, and full faculty approval. To parallel area colleges in implementing a "one repeat per program" policy, Yuba College is implementing a re-admission process that will be in the best interest of student learning, and consideration for use of faculty time for repeating students.

II. Application: Applies to all students who have previously been admitted in the Yuba College Nursing Program (or requesting transfer from another Nursing school), who did not complete a nursing course. Students must have submitted and been approved for re-admission.

III. Policy: Full faculty approved the following: Readmission to the program will only be available to returning/transfer students whom have been out of the program for two semesters or less. If student has been out of any Nursing Program for more than two semesters, they are invited to re-apply as a new student
